

# Al Mohallatul Mohammediyah

## Admission Summary 2012

Admissions have come to an end in Al Mohallatul Mohammediyah. A young AMM Education Team has worked very hard these past few months to ensure that the maximum number of children get admitted in Standard Schools.

In its 2<sup>nd</sup> year, the AMM team was given the objective of making sure that all school going or eligible children upto the age of 7.5 years in the Mohalla are admitted in Standard Schools. Thus, not only did the Mohalla Team work on new admissions, but simultaneously, they also worked on convincing parents of moving their children studying in sub-standard schools to good quality ones. Last year, the Mohalla's target was not-going-to-school children upto 6.5 years.

The Mohalla Team also worked on improving the quality of the AMM database. A Gift Hamper Scheme was carried out at the time of Salgirah of Aqa Mola (TUS).

Current statistics of the Mohalla for children upto 7.5 years are as follows;

For the purpose of following up on children who go to Montessori only schools, we keep them in the sub-standard category. The objective is to monitor them till they become 5.5 years of age and make sure that they select a standard school that goes upto Matric. Of the 23 children shown in the sub-standard category, 21 are in standard montessoris.

When schools reopen in August, after summer vacations, we will once again take up the matter of the 7 children not yet going to school.

Our thanks to the AMM Education Team for the effort they have put in. It was a huge challenge for a young team and they have performed admirably.
