### **Matriculation to College 2013**

Saleh Mohalla has completed the follow up of Matric 2013 Students. With 50 students in the Mohalla, it is a tough task with a large number of students to follow over a period of almost a year. The fact that only a handful of students are on financial assistance makes the task even more challenging.

77% of the children studying in standard schools managed to secure a B or a higher grade.

Out of 50 students, 2 students failed in one or more papers and will now be counselled to appear in supplementary exams. 12 of the students are enrolled in private colleges and 35 are admitted in government colleges under the CAP Scheme. 1 boy is being counselled for Vocational Studies.

With 47 out of 50 students already enrolled in colleges, 94% of the children are pursuing education beyond Matriculation.

Choice of studies for these children in College (HSC-II) is as follows;
